

Legacy Summit 2016 Update

We are very excited to update you about a change in our Legacy plans. When we designed the Hunter Hills Campus, we chose to reduce the size of the worship center from 1,000 seats to 700 seats, in order to save money. We also cut the footprint of the new next generation building in half. However, due to some new developments, we will now be able to build the original 1,000-seat worship center. The increased worship center capacity will now allow us to move the Downtown Campus, Daystar En Español and the New Garden Campus to the new Hunter Hills property! We have also decided to transition our Northern Guilford Campus from Northern Guilford High School to Kernodle Middle School and rename this campus the Horse Pen Creek Campus. These changes will:

- Allow two-thirds of our church to move into a new, permanent facility
- Allow our Northern Guilford Campus to move next to the future home of our permanent Horse Pen Creek Campus. This location is conveniently located in a densely populated area with lots of amenities. We believe this transition will help this campus to continue to grow!
- Speed up the timeline for building the Horse Pen Creek Campus by increasing our growth and momentum at Hunter Hills.
- Allow us to maximize our resources by saving money and better utilizing our leaders and A-Team.

FAQ's in Regards to Changes

1) Why did we change our plans?

The increased capacity of the Hunter Hills Campus created a great opportunity to put three campuses in a beautiful new facility. We believe this will also speed up the timeline for constructing the Horse Pen Creek Campus by increasing our growth and momentum as a church.

2) When will all these changes take place?

We are currently planning for all of the campuses to transition in August 2017. That would allow us to have our grand opening for all campuses on September 10th.

3) What will happen to the Campus Pastors?

For several months, the Lead Staff Team has been talking and praying with Pastor Ian and Pastor Jason about their next steps. They both believe God is leading them into a new season of ministry, and we are working with them to figure out what those steps are and when they will take place. Both men have both served Daystar well and we want to do all we can to help them make a good transition. Once the Downtown, New Garden and Español campuses move into the new building, Pastor Jonathan will serve as campus pastor for the Hunter Hills Campus. Pastor Jonathan and Pastor Ian will be working together over the next few months on that transition. When the Northern Guilford Campus moves and becomes the Horse Pen Creek Campus, Pastor Eric will step in as campus pastor. Pastor Jason and Pastor Eric will be working together over the next few months on that transition as well. Please join the staff in praying for Pastor Jason and Pastor Ian as they are seeking God for their next steps. We will keep everyone informed as these transitions develop!

4) When will we build the Horse Pen Creek Campus?

We grow and build at the speed of your generosity. Your level of involvement in Legacy could allow us to begin all the design work for the Horse Pen Creek Campus as early as 2017 and the site work in 2018. Our goal is to be in both buildings within three years. We believe the changes described here and your generosity will help speed up this process.

5) How do I pick a campus?

We would like everyone from our Downtown Campus and most people from the New Garden Campus to move into the Hunter Hills Campus. However, no one will ever be required to attend a particular campus. If you are having trouble making this decision, speak to your campus pastor to help determine what is best for you and your family. We want this to be a joyful and successful change for everyone.

6) What will happen to the leaders and A-Team members at each campus?

The campus pastors will be working together over the next year to consolidate teams and help each person find their best spot. There will be plenty of opportunities (existing and new) for everyone to serve and develop as leaders and A-Team members.

7) Will there be any other staff changes?

Not that we know of. However, as we continue to develop and build leaders, it is healthy for some of them to transition into other opportunities. Just imagine if kids never grew up and moved out of their parent's home; that would not be healthy. A good sign of a healthy church is leaders being sent out to build the kingdom all over the world. When this happens, we want to do all we can to help that person and their family make a good transition.

8) How many people can Kernodle Middle School accommodate?

In three services, we should be able to accommodate up to 900 people. We will begin with two services, and as we grow we will determine if a third service is needed.

10) Will the experience at the New Garden Campus be the same as at the Northern Guilford Campus?

Yes, we desire and plan for every campus to provide the same quality experience.

11) How much have we raised for Legacy so far?

We have raised almost \$1.4 million.

12) How much are we spending on the Hunter Hills Campus?

We have spent \$1.6 million to purchase the building, which was valued at almost \$4 million. We are still working to finalize the complete renovation budget, as construction costs have increased significantly this year. The trustees are working with our Lead Staff to ensure we get the best possible price.

13) Why do we want to leave the schools?

The schools can decide at any moment to stop letting us use their building, putting our ministry in a very vulnerable position. Also, due to the fact that much of Greensboro tends to have more traditional ideas about religion, the majority of our first-time guests prefer attending permanent, dedicated facilities, which are currently limited to our Downtown campus.

14) Will we launch other campuses in the future?

We still plan to launch other campuses in the future, but right now we are not sure when or where that will happen.

15) What are we going to do with the extra portable church equipment?

We are planning to utilize almost all of the portable equipment we currently have at the Hunter Hills Campus and the Horse Pen Creek Campus.

16) How does this affect Daystar En Español?

These changes should not affect the plans for Daystar En Español. They will move into the new Hunter Hills Campus next summer as planned.
